



# How to Protect Yourself & Others



## Get Vaccinated

Authorized COVID-19 vaccines can help protect you from COVID-19.



## Wear a mask

 Everyone 2 years or older who is not fully vaccinated should <u>wear a mask</u> in indoor public places.



# Stay 6 feet away from others

- Inside your home
  - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
  - If possible, maintain 6 feet between the person who is sick and other household members.



# Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces

 Being in crowded places like restaurants, bars, fitness centers, or movie theaters puts you at higher risk for COVID-19.



## Test to prevent spread to others

- Testing can give you information about your risk of spreading COVID-19.
- You can choose from many different types of tests.
- Regardless of the test type you select, a <u>positive test result</u> means that you
  have an infection and should <u>isolate</u> and inform your <u>close contacts</u> to avoid
  spreading disease to others.



# Wash your hands often

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially
after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or
sneezing.
