Exodus 4:10-12

"10 But Moses said to the Lord, "O my Lord, I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor even now that you have spoken to your servant; but I am slow of speech and slow of tongue." ¹¹ Then the Lord said to him, "Who gives speech to mortals? Who makes them mute or deaf, seeing or blind? Is it not I,

the Lord? ¹² Now go, and I will be with your mouth and teach you what you are to speak."

Moses knew he had a speech problem, yet God selected him to be the spokesman for Children of Israel before the Egyptian leaders. 


Mission of Hope
