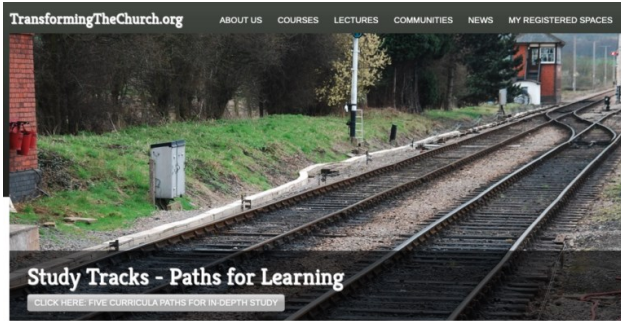

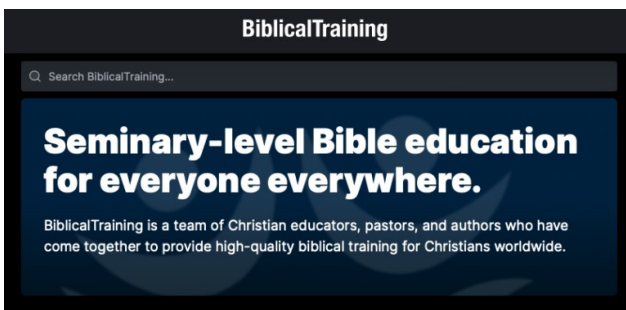

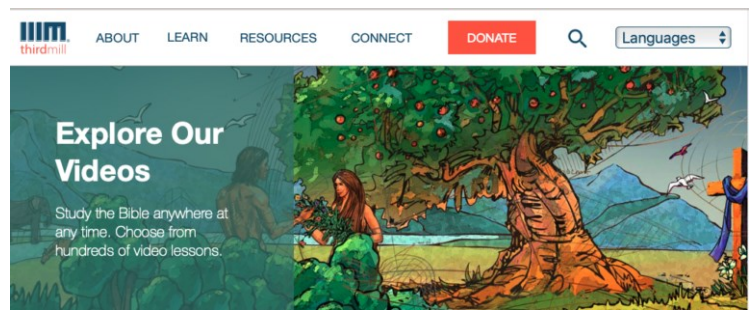

Rev. Dr. Jamie Eaddy is a thanatologist, public theologian, and founder of Thoughtful Transitions, LLC. She is dedicated to challenging oppressive systems and creating sacred spaces for healing. As an educator, chaplain, and activist, she specializes in grief support, trauma-informed care, and death doula services. Dr. Eaddy serves as the Director of Counseling for the Anti-Violence Partnership of Philadelphia, where she provides critical support to communities impacted by violence and loss, particularly survivors of crime and co-survivors of homicide. Her role as an educator extends into academia, where she teaches at several theological institutions, including Lancaster Theological Seminary, Columbia Theological Seminary, and Colgate Rochester Crozer Divinity School, her alma mater.



Dr. Dan Moseley

Dr. Dan Moseley is a respected executive coach/consultant who has helped individuals and organizations navigate the changes and conflicts in life. He is a nationally known lecturer and workshop leader in issues of leadership, loss, change and transition. Dr. Moseley was a seminary professor for 13 years at Christian Theological Seminary in Indianapolis, IN. Prior to that work, he was a pastor for over 30 years. His master's degree and doctorate were earned at Vanderbilt University. He has been instrumental in the development of organizations offering Pastoral Care and Counseling and Grief Healing. Dr. Moseley was the President of the Disciples Peace Fellowship for the Christian Church and founding pastor of Insight Counseling Centers. There are eight offices throughout middle Tennessee.



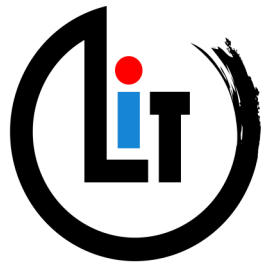


Mission of Hope

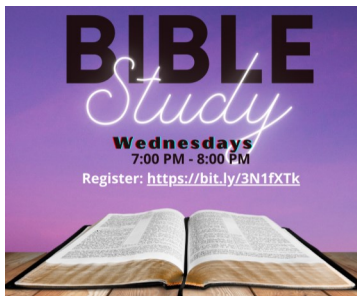

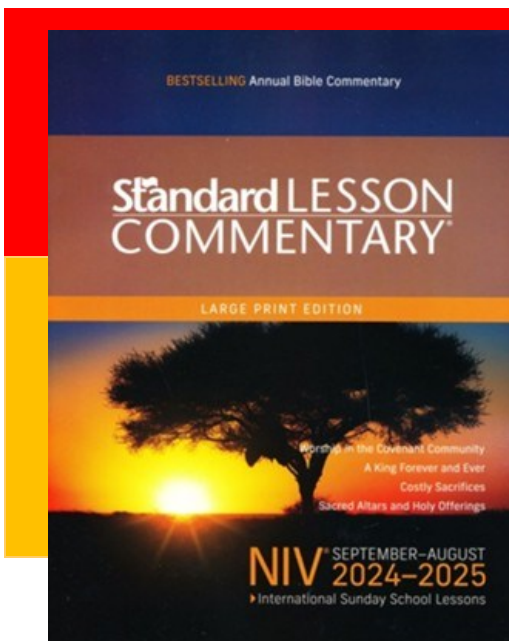
