It’s about your spiritual health and relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Peter tells us how we can grow in Christ by humbling ourselves.

Humbling ourselves involves much prayer and work so that with God’s help, we can examine our living. Where we fall short, we will need God to help us to overcome.

Isaiah 40:29-31 says *“29He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. 30Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; 31but*

will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.”

Rather than waiting until Ash Wednesday to start preparing for your spiritual renewal, start now. In the words of the Apostle Paul, *“Therefore, since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.”* (2 Corinthians 7:1)

Prepare to humble yourself under God’s hand, with God’s hand for God and watch what God does. There is a promise to lift you up because God cares for you. Make that step to be lifted up.
